Treasurer's Report

This is about the busiest time for events in the TOOB calendar and in July we have had three major events and of course the Sun fest is our busiest event of the year. So hats of to all the volunteers who turned out to help.

If we look at the two earlier events we had a bit of a setback financially because of weather and other issues beyond our direct control. The day of the Summer fest at Wellbrook winery for those who remember was wet and I do mean wet. Well at least the morning was I was fortunate enough to be on the afternoon shift which was better but I think the morning weather set the tone for the event and the turn out by the public was much less than previous years. This was reflected in a significant reduction in profit compared to last year by almost \$1500.00

to only just over \$400.00. The proceeds from this event of course are earmarked for a donation to the Delta Hospital Auxiliary.

The following day we had the Annual Wally Hill Memorial Golf Tournament and the weather was a bit kinder. However we could not use our normal venue at Tsawwassen Golf Club so we had rearranged and played at Delta Golf Club but the entries were down on last year. This may be the change of venue or the poor weather this summer. The upshot was again we were down on the final profit by just over \$500.00.

Sorry if I'm sounding all doom and gloom but I don't think any of this reflects on the organisers or volunteers for they all gave of their best as usual

and my own thoughts are the weather was a major factor in both events. However the saving grace was of course the Sun fest and the weather at last was good so we had an excellent weekend plus with a bit of judicious buying (well donations in truth) we were able to reduce our outgoing significantly and the end result is we made about \$700.00 more than last year.

The bottom line is we the TOOB presently have a reasonable amount of working capital around \$6K in hand plus we have \$15K in our term deposit and we still expect the Gaming Commission to fulfil their commitment of another grant of \$22K later in August or early September. So we should be in a position to make donations to the worthy causes of Tsawwassen and Ladner in September in our normal manner.
