The TOOB executive approached the Delta Secondary's Careers Programs Community Liaison Yvette Livingston regarding creating a bursary for a deserving high school student. Old Bastard Don Rodgers coordinated with Yvette and helped bring together the reality of a \$1,000.00 bursary being awarded to a Delta Senior Secondary student this year. Yvette says "as per your club's wishes we will advertise the award and our scholarship committee will meet to review applicants and confirm the recipient. The award will be presented at our Valedictory ceremony on Wednesday June 29 in the evening at the South Delta Baptist Church."

The bursary will be awarded based on the following:


