Government assistance for her transport would have had to go to committee and tons of paperwork. The other contribution was to support the purchase of two hearing aids for an autistic man, who was facing a long enduring process to get provincial aid or risk losing his job. These are two examples of the requests the TOOB receives and acts on.

The TOOB was second place in the SDSS Youth Philanthropy Initiative. The public school grade 10 project entails that students advocate for a charity in front of their class. If the presentation is successful then it is presented to a panel of judges in hopes of receiving \$5000 for our chosen charity. The TOOB has been involved in this project for several years running and we enjoy working with youth in their discovery of charitable involvement in our community.
